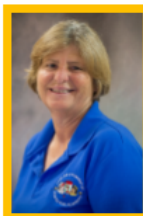

First Day Of School Reminders For Kindergarten Students: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- Please be sure to scan in your child every morning in the Brightwheel APP on your phone. This is our means of ensuring that ratios are maintained in every class and that we send in enough lunches into our classrooms. Once your child is scanned in they should report as follows:
- 7:30-8:00 Report to the Science Lab 8:00-8:20 Drop off at the classroom
- All students should be in their seats ready to learn at 8:20. Students arriving after 8:25 will be marked TARDY. **Children arriving after 8:20 are considered tardy and must be left at the main office to be walked to class by a member of the office staff. To minimize disruption during opening exercises (the most important part of the day) parents MAY NOT drop off children at their classrooms. Teachers have been advised to not answer the front door after 8:20 or prior to the afternoon pick up times. After the third tardy children will not be admitted late and will be sent home unless accompanied by a doctor's note.**
- **Please do not call into the classroom during instructional time. If you need to speak to the teacher during the school day, please call during Spanish class or PE.**
- Due to our USDA Food Program guidelines outside food must be consumed prior to entering the building.
- You can message the teacher in the Brightwheel app. Please refrain from calling the classroom during the school day. We will also do our best to send 2-3 photos weekly in this APP. Each Friday, the director will send a weekly letter to your email and in the APP. The teacher will also send a letter. This recap will also include developmental milestone, events of our week, Student of The Week, and upcoming activities.
- We will provide all school supplies and a school bag. Please do not send a backpack or any items from home other than a lightweight SOLID COLOR jacket and a water bottle.
- Please check your child's homework and sign the homework binder nightly. If your child is in afterschool care we will assist with homework however, parents should check homework nightly for accuracy.
- ABSENCES: PLEASE DO NOT PLAN TRIPS OR VACATIONS ON SCHOOL DAYS. Please refer to the school calendar to schedule days out from school on NON INSTRUCTIONAL DAYS. **Make up work will only be given to children who are out sick, the same applies for make up testing.** Excessive absences COULD affect your child's overall grades.
- Students may attend one fieldtrip a month. If your child is in attendance on that day, your account will be billed \$8.
 - Items to bring to school:
 - A change of clothing **marked with your child's name placed in a gallon zip lock bag** that will be left in your child's cubbie until it is used. Once clothing is soiled, it will be sent home and you are asked to replace it with clean clothing. **The school uniform is required.**

- The polo must be worn Monday – Thursday and the polo or school T-Shirt must be worn on Fridays. Over the summer, you can wear either the polo or the school T-shirt every day. If your child comes to school without their uniform, we will provide one and bill your account.
- Your child may wear shorts, leggings or pants, **Skirts and tutu's are not permitted.**
- If you wish to send a jacket, it must be a plain solid jacket with the child's name written inside. **No printed jackets for those with superhero themes.**
- **Please do not send in jewelry, headbands or toys of any kind.**
- Sneakers should be able to slide on or use Velcro. **No laces please and No CROCS.**
- **Except earrings, NO JEWELRY OF ANY KIND IS PERMITTED.**
- Student who are not part of the afterschool program should be signed out at 2:30. After signing out ring the bell and you will be given a pick up pass. Take the pass to the classroom and the teacher will release your child. The same procedure should be followed when picking up students from afterschool care.
- When you arrive for pick up, ring the bell at the front door after scanning out and get a pick up pass. Take that pick up pass and give it to the teacher.
 - Students attending until 2:30 should be picked up at the classroom.
 - If you pick up before 4:30 take the pick-up pass to the classroom and the teacher will release your child. **THE TEACHERS WILL NOT RELEASE KIDS WITH OUT A PICK UP PASS.** This is to ensure that only authorized individuals pick up.
 - If you pick up from 4:30 on, you will find your child on the playground. After getting the pass and signing out in the APP, ring the bell and your child will be released once you hand the card to the teacher.
 - **Each Friday, the director will send a weekly letter to your email and in the APP. The teacher will also send a letter. This recap will also include developmental milestone, events of our week, Student of The Week, and upcoming activities.**
 - Some months, VPK kids may attend one fieldtrip a month. If your child is in attendance on that day, your account will be billed \$8. Fieldtrip dates are listed on the calendar.
- We do our best to keep our school healthy. PLEASE KEEP SICK CHILDREN HOME. If while at school your child develops a fever, diarrhea or has excessive nasal discharge you will be called to pick up. Please come as quick as possible as your child will be quarantined in the main office. **Children who are send home with a fever cannot return the next day as they must be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school.** If your child has a communicable disease they must have a doctor's note to return to school.
- **Although our staff is vaccinated against the COVID Virus we cannot control if a child comes to our school with COVID. You will be notified immediately if this is the case.**

- Asegúrese de escanear a su hijo todas las mañanas en la aplicación Brightwheel en su teléfono. Este es nuestro medio para garantizar que se mantengan las proporciones en cada clase y que enviemos suficientes almuerzos a nuestras aulas. Una vez que su hijo sea escaneado, debe informar lo siguiente:
 - 7:30-8:00 Informe al Laboratorio de Ciencias 8:00-8:20 Entrega en el aula
 - Todos los estudiantes deben estar en sus asientos listos para aprender a las 8:20. Los estudiantes que lleguen después de las 8:25 serán marcados TARDE. Los niños que llegan después de las 8:20 se consideran tardíos y deben dejarse en la oficina principal para que un miembro del personal de la oficina los acompañe a clase. Para minimizar la interrupción durante los ejercicios de apertura (la parte más importante del día), los padres NO PUEDEN dejar a los niños en sus aulas. Se ha aconsejado a los maestros que no respondan a la puerta principal después de las 8:20 o antes de la hora de recogida de la tarde. Después de la tercera tardanza, los niños no serán admitidos tarde y serán enviados a casa a menos que vayan acompañados de una nota del médico.
 - Debido a nuestras pautas del Programa de Alimentos del USDA, los alimentos externos deben consumirse antes de ingresar al edificio.
 - Puede enviar un mensaje al profesor en la aplicación Brightwheel. Por favor, absténgase de llamar al aula durante el día escolar. También haremos todo lo posible para enviar 2-3 fotos semanalmente en esta aplicación. Cada viernes, el director enviará una carta semanal a su correo electrónico y en la APP. El profesor también enviará una carta. Este resumen también incluirá hitos del desarrollo, eventos de nuestra semana, Estudiante de la semana y próximas actividades.
 - Proporcionaremos todos los útiles escolares y una mochila escolar. Por favor, no envíe una mochila o cualquier artículo de su casa que no sea una chaqueta ligera de COLOR SÓLIDO y una botella de agua.
 - Por favor, revise la tarea de su hijo y firme la carpeta de tareas todas las noches. Si su hijo está en cuidado después de la escuela, lo ayudaremos con la tarea, sin embargo, los padres deben verificar la precisión de la tarea todas las noches.
 - AUSENCIAS: POR FAVOR NO PLANIFIQUE VIAJES O VACACIONES EN DÍAS ESCOLARES. Consulte el calendario escolar para programar días fuera de la escuela en DÍAS NO LECTIVOS. El trabajo de recuperación solo se dará a los niños que están enfermos, lo mismo se aplica a las pruebas de recuperación. Las ausencias excesivas PODRÍAN afectar las calificaciones generales de su hijo.
 - Los estudiantes pueden asistir a una excursión al mes. Si su hijo asiste ese día, se le facturará a su cuenta \$8.
 - Artículos para llevar a la escuela:
 - o Un cambio de ropa marcado con el nombre de su hijo colocado en una bolsa con cierre hermético de un galón que se dejará en el cubículo de su hijo hasta que se use. Una vez que la ropa esté sucia, se enviará a casa y se le pedirá que la reemplace con ropa limpia. Se requiere el uniforme escolar.
 - o El polo debe usarse de lunes a jueves y el polo o la camiseta de la escuela deben usarse los viernes. Durante el verano, puedes usar el polo o la camiseta de la escuela todos los días. Si su hijo viene a la escuela sin su uniforme, le proporcionaremos uno y le facturaremos su cuenta. Su hijo puede usar pantalones cortos, leggings o pantalones, no se permiten faldas ni tutú.

 - o Tazas de yogur o yogur bebible (1 por niño)
 - o Tazas de gelatina individuales y una lata de spray de crema batida

Los niños que son enviados a casa con fiebre no pueden regresar al día siguiente, ya que deben estar libres de fiebre durante 24 horas antes de regresar a la escuela. Si su hijo tiene una enfermedad transmisible, debe tener una nota del médico para regresar a la escuela.
- Aunque nuestro personal está vacunado contra el virus COVID, no podemos controlar si un niño viene a nuestra escuela con COVID. Se le notificará inmediatamente si este es el caso.
