

THE ROAD THROUGH

Child Find



A request for Child Find services is received.



Child Find sends a referral packet to parent/guardian.



A Child Find Specialist reviews the referral packet. Parent/guardian is contacted to schedule a screening.

Child Find Screening Team conducts screening.

The M-DCPS Pre-K Diagnostic Team sends the completed case to the M-DCPS Pre-K ESE Department. The M-DCPS Pre-K ESE Department contacts the parent/guardian to schedule a staffing.

The M-DCPS Pre-K Diagnostic Team conducts formal evaluation(s) in the area(s) of concern.

The M-DCPS Pre-K Diagnostic Team contacts the parent/guardian to schedule the evaluation appointment(s).

If the screening indicates that the child needs further evaluation, the case is sent to the assigned M-DCPS Pre-K Diagnostic team.

If the screening indicates that the child does not need further evaluation, the case is closed and referrals to community agencies are facilitated (as needed).

The M-DCPS Pre-K ESE Department conducts a staffing to discuss the evaluation results and determine eligibility for ESE Services.



The child is eligible for ESE services. An IEP is developed.

Parent/guardian registers the child at assigned school for ESE Services.

If the child is not eligible for ESE services, referrals to community agencies are facilitated (as needed).
